Induction Thursday, August 3rd:

1. Table tent advertising/Rep. Co. Economic Development: We will advertise HBHoF summer activities in the July table tents for \$100.
2. Banquet meal: Consensus was to have pork loin or baked steak on the menu & cheesy potatoes, green beans, salad, roll & ice cream cups.
3. Table decorations: Consensus was to ask Cheryl Glenn to be in charge of table decorations.

Museum Displays (outdoors & indoors):

1. Winners Circle #2: A donor has offered funds towards the concrete portion.
2. South lawn seeding: Target date for lawn seeding is this Fall.
3. DVD/TV Entertainment System: Discussion was to continue plans for a DVD/TV Educational Media.
4. Banner proposal in new addition: Discussion was about putting up a large horizontal banner and/or several vertical banners on the east wall of the new addition.
5. Game Race Car: Ryan Boyer and Matt Cole fixed and tuned up the system so it works. We will charge a nominal fee (suggested \$3/8 laps).
6. Mowing lawn & shed entryway: Volunteers Jill Boyer and son, Brody Boyer, mowed the lawn April 17. We need a ramp into the shed to prevent damage to the new lawn mower deck.

Gift Shop: Jackets with logo: Don McChesney reported Purple Splash will work with us on placing orders throughout the year.

Membership: Membership mailings need to be mailed by May 15, 2017. Membership Committee (Stacy Saip, Ch., Ken Effenbeck, Barry Bottger, Renn Allsman, and Karol McChesney) will meet April 24th, after the 7:00 Advertising meeting, to stuff envelopes.
